TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement was prepared on behalf of Peg Broadcasting, LLC ("Peg"), licensee of radio station WTRZ, Channel 297A, Spencer, Tennessee.¹ Peg also holds an outstanding permit to relocate the facilities of the WTRZ auxiliary antenna system (BXPB-20090219AAB). Peg herein submits a license application to cover this outstanding permit. A calculation of the transmitter power output of the WTRZ auxiliary antenna is attached as Exhibit A.

There is one operating condition/restriction on the WTRZ auxiliary antenna permit. The condition requires Peg to lower the power, or cease operation of the auxiliary facility, in coordination with other tower users to protect persons having access to the site from radio frequency electromagnetic fields in excess of the FCC guidelines. Peg will comply with this condition. It is believed that the WTRZ auxiliary antenna has been constructed in compliance with the Commission's rules.

1) Peg has a license for both a main and auxiliary facility for WTRZ.
