

Date of Establishment

The Peralta Community College District ("Applicant") was established in 1964, by popular vote (see Exhibit 10a), as a political subdivision of the State of California and is a comprehensive, public, two-year institution offering educational services to residents of the surrounding area.

The Applicant operates under a locally elected seven-member Board of Trustees form of government, which establishes the policies and procedures by which the Applicant operates operates four college campuses located in Alameda, Oakland, and Berkeley, California.

While the Applicant is a political subdivision of the State of California, it is legally separate and is independent of other State and local governments.

The Applicant intends, if granted a FPFM license, to establish a radio station at one of its colleges, Laney College in Oakland, California, can be traced back to the Central Trade School founded in 1927 by the Oakland Board of Education.
