

**Multiple Ownership Exhibit**  
**Form 301 Section II Question 4(b) Exhibit 5**

Miriam Media, Inc. (“Miriam Media”) and its principals by virtue of being the winning bidder in Auction 70, now hold the right to file long form applications, but do not yet hold permits for new FM stations in the following markets: Willow Creek, CA; Ballinger, TX; Benjamin, TX; Childress, TX; and Turkey, TX. Further, neither Miriam Media, nor any of its principals hold any other cognizable interest in other broadcast facilities.

Section 73.3555(a)(iv) limits the cognizable interests in AM or FM radio broadcast stations that a person or single entity (or entities under common control) may have in a local radio market, like Willow Creek California, a radio market with 14 or fewer full-power, commercial and noncommercial radio stations to not more than 5 commercial radio stations in total and not more than 3 commercial stations in the same service (AM or FM), and provides that no person or single entity (or entities under common control) may have a cognizable interest in more than 50% of the full-power, commercial and noncommercial radio stations in such market unless the combination of stations comprises not more than one AM and one FM station.

Because neither Miriam Media, nor either of its principals hold a cognizable interest in any existing FM or AM station in the Willow Creek, California area, nor any adjacent market, nor with any overlapping predicted contours with the proposed station, a grant of the instant application will result in Miriam Media having a cognizable interest in but a single FM station in the market. Accordingly following a grant of the instant application, Miriam Media and its principals will remain in full compliance with the multiple ownership restrictions contained within Section 73.3555 of the Commission’s Rules.
