

Exhibit 5 – Compliance with Local Radio Ownership Rule

Charles River Broadcasting Company (“Charles River”) is the licensee of WKLB-FM, Waltham, Massachusetts. Charles River is a subsidiary of Greater Media, Inc. (“Greater Media”). For purposes of the local radio ownership rule, WKLB-FM is deemed to be a part of the Boston, Massachusetts Arbitron Metro. WKLB-FM is licensed to Waltham in Middlesex County, Massachusetts, which is located within the Boston, Massachusetts Metro, as defined by Arbitron.

The attached Exhibit was compiled on March 2, 2009 using BIA Research, Inc.’s *Media Access Pro* database. The Exhibit lists all radio stations, including WKLB-FM, that are licensed to communities within the counties comprising the Boston, Massachusetts Metro or that Arbitron designates as “home” to that Metro. As demonstrated in the Exhibit, there are at least 82 operating stations in the Boston, Massachusetts Metro, as so defined. Under the local radio ownership rule, a person or single entity (or entities under common control) in a radio market with 45 or more full-power, commercial and noncommercial radio stations may have a cognizable interest in up to 8 commercial radio stations, not more than 5 of which are in the same service (AM or FM).

As shown in the Exhibit, Greater Media controls 5 FM radio stations in the Boston, Massachusetts Metro, including WKLB-FM, which fully complies with the local radio ownership rule.
