Northeast Gospel Broadcasting Inc. International Border Compliance Dolgeville, New York

The application is within 320 km of the Canadian border, however the Proposal complies with §73.207(b)(2), and the Working Arrangement for the Allotment and Assignment of FM Broadcasting Channels under the Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the United States of America relating to the FM Broadcasting Service.

There are several Canadian allotments considered. The Proposed site complies with the minimum distance separation to the Perth, Ontario, class A allotment, and the Montreal, Quebec, class C1 allotment. The Proposal complies with Section 5.2.2.3 of the "Working Arrangement" to the Cornwall, Ontario, class B allotment. The Proposed stations' 34 dBu interfering contour does not cross the U.S./Canadian border. Table 1 shows the requisite distance separation to the allotments along with the actual distance. Figure 1 of this exhibit shows the lack of overlap between the Proposed interfering contour and the Canadian border.

Therefore, the application complies with the requirements of section 73.207(b)(2) and the "Working Arrangement" relating to Canadian stations and allotments.


