

**Compliance with Special Operating Conditions**

The Construction Permit contains several Special Operating Conditions, summarized as follows:

1. The permittee must provide the results of a complete proof-of-performance to establish the horizontal plane radiation patterns for both the horizontally and vertically polarized radiation components.
2. The permittee must provide an affidavit from a licensed surveyor to establish that the directional antenna has been oriented at the proper azimuth.
3. The permittee must submit an affidavit that a qualified engineer oversaw the installation of the directional antenna system.
4. The permittee must provide a statement that the relative field strength of neither the measured horizontally nor vertically polarized radiation component exceeds, at any azimuth, the value indicated on the composite radiation pattern authorized by the construction permit.
5. The permittee/licensee is subject to a four-year holding period continuing until the facility has achieved four years of on-air operations.
6. Waiver of 47 C.F.R. Section 73.1125 has been granted to allow operation of the facility authorized by this construction permit as a satellite operation of station KLVR-FM, Middletown, CA (FIN 18801).
7. The permittee/licensee, in coordination with other users of the site, must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower, or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.

5. EMF agrees that, pursuant to 47 CFR Section 73.7005(a), it is subject to a holding period. Should EMF propose to assign or transfer the construction permit/license to another party prior to four years of on-air operation, it agrees to demonstrate the following two factors: that the proposed buyer would qualify for at least the same number of points as EMF originally received; and that consideration received and/or promised does not exceed EMF's legitimate and prudent expenses as defined therein.
6. EMF reiterates the commitments outlined in its request for waiver of section 73.1125. See also Exhibit 6.
7. EMF agrees to reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower, or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.

Therefore, all Special Operating Conditions of the WZKL Construction Permit (FCC File Number BPED-19990917MM) have been met.
