

Cross-Ownership Compliance

The proposed transaction will result in common ownership of two commercial full-service television stations and six commercial radio stations.¹ An entity may directly or indirectly own, operate or control up to two commercial TV stations, pursuant to 73.3555(c)(1), and six commercial radio stations, to the extent permitted by 73.3555(a), if at least 20 independently-owned media voices would remain in the market post-transaction.

As shown on the table below, more than 20 independently owned media voices will remain in San Juan, Puerto Rico, after the consummation of the transfer. Considerably more independent voices can be shown if the market is expanded to include all of Puerto Rico, but we have limited our analysis to the San Juan metro for simplicity. The proposed transaction therefore complies with the Commission's cross-ownership rules and should be granted.
