Dear Barry:

As a follow-up to our conversation regarding Radio Stations WJNS-FM and WKXY (FM), this letter is presented to you as explanation of the current situation and events preceding it. As you know, my client, Family Worship Center Church, Inc. ("FWCC"), is the Licensee of Radio Station WJNS-FM, Yazoo City, Mississippi. FWCC was recently granted an application to change the station's community of license from Yazoo City to Bentonia, Mississippi (See BPED-20070611AKN). As part of this community change, FWCC will be relocating to a tower owned by American Tower in Flora, Mississippi. Since the grant of this community of license change application, FWCC has been working with American Tower to initiate the move. At the same time, FWCC had continued to operate at its location in Yazoo City. On September 13th, due to high winds associated with Hurricane Ike, the WJNS-FM tower collapsed and the station is currently off the air. Since WJNS-FM is presently scheduled to relocate to the new tower, which FWCC expects to complete within the next 40 days, I can confirm to you that FWCC will not return to the air at its present licensed site in Yazoo City.
