Re: Proposed Minor Change Application for KMLV (FM) Ralston, NE

Dear Mr. Jenkins:

WOWT-TV consents to the filing of a minor change to the current license of KMLV, Channel 201, Ralston, NE at its current coordinates and raising the COR to 346 meters above ground and the ERP to a maximum of 45,500 watts.

WOWT-TV requires that Educational Media Foundation ("EMF") be responsible for resolving any and all interference complaints, which might arise due to this increase in power to its current operation on Channel 6. Remedies could include the installation of TVI filters, which, if necessary, will be installed at no expense to WOWT or its viewers.

EMF has agreed that should it not be able to acceptably resolve all interference complaints to the satisfaction of WOWT-TV (in WOWT-TV's sole discretion) it will, upon request of WOWT-TV, cease operations and petition the FCC for authority to reduce power to a level acceptable to WOWT-TV,

WOWT reserves the right to delay and or cease the actual construction of the proposed upgrade until the end of NTSC broadcasting (currently scheduled for February 17, 2009) in the event that, after examining the details of the proposed construction, WOWT determines, in its sole discretion, that the construction might cause widespread interference to its viewers.
