**Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Emmis Radio License, LLC ("Emmis"), the licensee of WFNI(AM), Indianapolis, Indiana, this is to request an extension of Emmis's special temporary authority ("STA") to operate WFNI with temporary antenna facilities. See File No. BSTA-20220713AAB. The Commission granted this STA on July 22, 2022 and it is scheduled to expire on January 18, 2023.

Under the subject STA, WFNI is operating on an interim basis at reduced power utilizing a rooftop antenna system at Emmis's studio/office building while efforts are finalized to locate a new permanent site. Emmis is currently in discussions with a prospective purchaser of WFNI who is working to finalize lease terms for a new permanent site for the station. Emmis respectfully requests an extension of the STA to allow time for completion of these efforts and the filing of an appropriate modification application.

The licensee has authorized undersigned counsel to certify on its behalf that the licensee is not subject to denial of Federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. § 862.
