ENGINEERING STATEMENT

The engineering data contained herein have been prepared on behalf of TRINITY BROADCASTING OF TEXAS, INC., permittee of KDTX-DT, Channel 45 in Dallas, Texas, in support of its Application for Modification of Construction Permit BPCDT-19991028AFX, to specify a change in transmitter site and other operating parameters.

Exhibit B provides directional antenna pattern data, and proposed operating parameters are tabulated in Exhibit C. Exhibit D is a map upon which the predicted service contours are plotted. As shown, the city of license is completely contained within the proposed 43 dBu service contour. Since the proposed ERP is greater than that specified in the allotment in certain directions, an allocation study is included in Exhibit E. A power density calculation is provided in Exhibit F. It is not expected that the proposed facility would cause objectionable interference to any other user of the site proposed herein. However, the owner of KDTX-DT recognizes its obligation to correct any such interference that may occur.

It is important to note that the coverage of the facility proposed herein does not exceed the coverage of the largest authorized DTV facility in the Dallas television market. Below is a tabulation of three other DTV facilities in the market that have coverage areas larger than that proposed herein:
