Assignee's Previously Qualified Noncommercial Educational Program

The Ohio State University (“OSU”), the proposed assignee of noncommercial educational radio station WDUB, has previously been granted broadcast applications by the Federal Communications Commission that found it qualified as a noncommercial educational (NCE) entity with a qualifying educational program. Upon assignment, OSU will use WDUB to advance an educational program similar to that the FCC has found qualifying in connection with its other NCE-licensed radio stations.

As detailed in Exhibit 16 to this application, OSU is the existing licensee of full power noncommercial educational television and FM radio stations WOSA(FM), Grove City, Ohio, WOSV(FM), Mansfield, Ohio, WOSU-TV, Columbus, Ohio, WOSP(FM), Portsmouth, Ohio, WOSU-FM, Columbus, Ohio, WOSE(FM), Coshocton, Ohio, WOSB(FM), Marion, Ohio. The OSU stations are community-supported public radio operations that broadcast a diverse mix of programs to communities and listeners throughout Ohio. The mission of the OSU stations is to educate, enrich, enlighten, and entertain people throughout its local communities by providing innovating, high quality noncommercial programming.

OSU certifies that it is a non-profit entity, that its governing documents permit its advancement of an educational program, and that there is no provision in any of those documents that would restrict it from advancing an educational program or complying with any FCC rule, policy, or provision of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

As the long-time licensee of several NCE radio stations, OSU has clearly demonstrated its commitment to, and capability of, providing educational radio broadcast programming, and plans to maintain such service with WDUB. OSU plans to operate WDUB in connection with its existing stations, and to continue to provide innovative noncommercial cultural and informational to address issues of concern and interest to residents in its listening areas (*see, e.g.*, <https://radio.wosu.org/schedule/week/wosu#stream/0>).
