Dear Mr. Oetting::

This is in reference to the request filed on January 28, 2022. PRI requests a further extension of the STA granted on November 8, 2017, to continue operating with DA parameters at variance to allow time to file an FCC Form 301 application to permanently change from DA to ND along with a power reduction.¹ In support of the request, PRI stated that Communication Technologies Inc.(CTI) is in the process of preparing an application for filing in the upcoming months.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA is **HEREBY GRANTED**, and PRI may continue to operate with day and night DA parameters at variance along with a reduced daytime power level (while maintaining all daytime monitor points within licensed limits). PRI must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310.

This authority expires on **August 10, 2022**.

¹ WSRV(AM) is licensed for operation on 1550 kHz using the same DA pattern with 1 kW (day) and 0.001 kW (night).
