Dear Applicant:

This refers to the above-captioned minor change application for K203FF.

An engineering study reveals the application is in violation of the interference protection requirements of 47 C.F.R. Section 74.1204. Specifically, the proposed 100 dBu interfering contour overlaps the 60 dBu protected contour of the authorized facilities of second-adjacent channel station KQIZ-FM, Amarillo, Texas (BLH-19841214KT) and the 60 dBu protected contour of third-adjacent channel station KMXJ-FM, Amarillo, Texas (BLH-19901210KB). The application does not recognize these defects. Accordingly, we dismiss the application as unacceptable for filing.

In light of the above, application BMPFT-20161031ADS is unacceptable for filing pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3566(a) and IS HEREBY DISMISSED. This action is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
