Dear Mr. Kitchen:

This is in reference to the request filed on November 13, 2017. Townsquare requests an extension of the STA granted on May 17, 2017, to continue operating with its nighttime pattern during daytime hours pending the filing of the required FCC Form 302 application to update all operating parameters (if any significant changes are needed).¹ In support of the request, Townsquare states that additional time is needed to complete repairs before it can resume licensed operations.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and Townsquare may continue to operate daytime using the licensed nighttime pattern with a maximum

power of 0.65 kW, while maintaining all daytime monitoring points within licensed limits (with no change to the licensed 1 kW nighttime DA operation). Townsquare must further reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310. We anticipate that Townsquare will file the application before the expiration date shown below, or submit an e-mail to my attention to certify the date the station resumed licensed operations (per BZ-20011115ADV) with negligible changes.

This authority expires on **June 6, 2018**.
