TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Cumulus Licensing LLC ("Cumulus"), licensee of WDZZ-FM, Channel 224A, Flint, Michigan. Cumulus herein proposes to make minor changes in the facilities of WDZZ-FM by relocating the station to a new tower site and increasing the antenna supporting structure height and height above average terrain.

Cumulus is proposing to locate WDZZ-FM at an existing tower site, which will be increased in height. As such, the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") has been apprised of the height increase. Once the revised Determination of No Hazard is issued, the owner of the tower will update the tower registration accordingly. At the site proposed in this application, Channel 224A does not meet the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements to three other licensed FM facilities. These shortages are based on the change of rules to allow Class A stations to increase power from 3.0 to 6.0 kilowatts and are considered pre-1989 grandfathered shortages (see Exhibit A for details). All other necessary documentation used to certify the technical portion of FCC Form 301 has been forwarded to the applicant and is available to the Commission upon request.
