

**STATEMENT IN SUPPORT OF
EXCLUSION FROM ENVIRONMENTAL PROCESSING
FOR
FM TRANSLATOR STATION W212BB, WAUSAU, WI**

Pensacola Christian College, Inc. (“PCC”), respectfully submits that it is categorically excluded from the requirements pertaining to the preparation of an environmental assessment (“EA”) respecting the license renewal application for FM translator station, W212BB, Wausau, WI (FCC Facility ID No. 88618).

Note 1 of Section 1.1306 allows that “the provisions of § 1.1307(a) do not encompass the mounting of antenna(s) on an existing building or antenna tower unless § 1.1307(a)(4) is applicable.” The W212BB antenna is located on an existing, registered tower. Accordingly, only § 1.1307(a)(4) may, be applicable, and it is not. To PCC’s best knowledge, following diligent inquiry, the tower on which the W212BB antenna is located does not affect a district, site, building, structure or object significant in American history, architecture, archeology, engineering or culture that is eligible for or is listed in the National Register of Historic Places.¹ Thus, W212BB is exempt from the requirements of § 1.1307(a).

Further, with respect to Section 1.1307(b) — pertaining to the limits of human exposure to levels of radio frequency radiation — the effective radiated power of W212BB is less than 100 watts. Translator stations, such as W212BB, are service

¹ Endeavors to complete due diligence in this regard include investigation of the applicable Antenna Structure Registration. The NEPA (National Environmental Policy Act of 1969) information found on the Antenna Structure Registration pertaining to historic districts, sites, buildings, structures or objects that are proximate to the tower is predicated on the representations therein by the owner of the tower that the tower is neither proximate to, or has an adverse impact upon historic sites listed on or eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.

classified under Part 74, Subpart L. Accordingly, as expressly provided in Table 1 to § 1.1307(b), W212BB is exempt from the provisions of § 1.1307(b).

In summary, the express exemptions contained in Sections 1.1306 and 1.1307(b) both are applicable to W212BB. Accordingly, no EA is required in connection with this License Renewal Application (FCC Form 303-S).
