**PETITION FOR RULEMAKING**

Georgia-Carolina Radiocasting Company, LLC (“Petitioner”) hereby submits this Petition for Rulemaking to assign FM Channel 238A to Edgefield, SC as that community’s *first full power* FM broadcast service, as follows:

<u>Community</u>	<u>Present</u>	<u>Proposed</u>
Edgefield, SC	---	238A

This makeup of allocations would represent a *preferential arrangement of the FM Table of Allotments*. The community of Edgefield, SC would receive its first FM allocation. Edgefield, county seat of Edgefield County, SC, is an incorporated community (generally sufficient for allotment purposes) with a 2010 United States Census population of 4,750 persons. It has its own library, police and fire departments, weekly newspaper, banks, churches and many other indicators of a bona-fide community for allotment purposes. Edgefield is governed by a mayor and six city council members. It is independent of any neighboring communities and is clearly deserving of its own FM allocation.

Concurrent with this Petition, Petitioner has filed a FCC Form 301 Construction Permit application (and associated fee), BNPH-20190805AAR, to construct a new FM facility at Edgefield, SC . In the event that the Commission grants Petitioner's requests herein, Petitioner asserts that it will participate in any future Commission auction to secure a broadcast license for said facility.
