CBS Radio Stations Inc. hereby requests Experimental Authority for Radio Station KXNT-FM to conduct tests of the HD Radio System using conditional access transmission on the HD-3 multicast channel. The experimental authority is requested pursuant to 47 C.F.R. 73.1510 for the period April 7th through April 22, 2011. KXNT-FM will use the tests to evaluate the usability of new conditional access receivers by users, the sound quality and signal coverage capabilities.

The tests will be conducted during the National Association of Broadcasters convention and will allow convention attendees to observe operating conditional access receivers. All testing will be conducted on KXNT-FM's regular transmission system. Because the HD-3 emission is added to the digital subcarriers closer to the center of the FM channel, and because the spectral power density will not be increased relative to the present primary main digital subcarriers, it is expected there will be no interference to other stations. However, all testing will be conducted on a non interference basis and in compliance with the NRSC-5-B Standard.
