ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

LOS ANGELES ACADEMY OF ARTS AND ENTERPRISE

A California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation

1. **Name.** The name of this Corporation is Los Angeles Academy of Arts and Enterprise.
2. **Purpose.** This Corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable and public purposes. The specific purpose of this Corporation is to establish, build and operate the Los Angeles Academy of Arts and Enterprise.
3. **Agent for Service of Process.** The name in the State of California of this corporation's initial agent for service of process is:

Paracorp Incorporated

4. **Charitable and Public Purposes.** This Corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and public purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law (the "Code").

a. *Compliance with Code Requirements for Tax-Exempt Organizations.*

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this Corporation, and the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.

Limitations on Political Activities. No substantial part of the activities of this Corporation shall consist of lobbying or carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and this corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office except as provided in Section 501(h) of the Code.


Assets Dedication to Charitable and Educational Purposes. The property of this Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable and educational purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this Corporation shall ever

insure to the benefit of any director, trustee, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person.

Distribution of Assets Upon Dissolution. Upon the winding up and dissolution of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment (or after provision for payment) of all debts and liabilities of this Corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and which has established its tax-exempt status under California Revenue and Taxation Code Section 23701(d) (or the corresponding section of any future California revenue and tax law) and which satisfies the requirements of the California Revenue and Taxation Code section 214.

5. **No Members.** The Corporation has no members.
