

Radio Free Roanoke – Educational Program Exhibit

Radio Free Roanoke (RFR) is a non-profit educational organization, registered on May 31, 2013 with the state of Virginia. We plan to engage, educate and entertain our listeners, through inclusive programming representing our diverse local community. We will provide programming designed and implemented by those whose interests are typically underserved by established radio stations in the Roanoke area. All participating members of Radio Free Roanoke are committed to collaborative processes to achieve this shared goal.

We at *RFR* will further our stated purpose by offering radio programming that responds to the interests of the local community derived through a democratic process. To provide programming for every hour of each week, we will actively encourage and maintain ways for local residents to participate with the creation and implementation of programming that aligns with our educational goals, including syndicated programming desired by our local residents. We define *educational* as programming that offers information and discussion in the interests of the local community. Radio Free Roanoke will in part serve as an advocate for those lacking media representation, such as, minorities, youth, and seniors.

Programming will range from daily local news bulletins to weekly and monthly shows. Our radio *Bulletin Board* will offer brief regular, timely and useful community information regarding weekly events throughout the day. Such events include: After-school programs/events in coordination with public and private schools; church and other cultural events; city-wide events; and any enrichment opportunities, fundraisers or advocacy information offered by local residents. The *RFR Bulletin Board* will be updated weekly and/or by special request call-ins as needed. The *RFR Bulletin Board* will be offered in languages other than English. Our educational programs will include the following (pending approval based on needs, scheduling and successful execution).*

Discussion/Political/Cultural/Economic/Opinion - *Comrade Zero*, *Caleb Coulter*, *Book Club Discussion*
Environmental / Knowledge – *Ron McCorkle* (permaculture/urbiculture show), *Dr. Rose Social Psych Hour*

Local/Historical/Senior – *James Tarpley Hour*

Youth – *Little Big Minds*, *Music Lab Radio*, *The Afterschool Radio Hour*

LGBT Community – *The Will Rye Show*

Non-English Speakers – *The Bridge*, *Musik!* (German language music program)

Advocacy/Support – *Autism Awareness Discussion*

Syndicated programs – *Democracy Now*, programs from Asheville, NC's local station

*In the case of a host's absence or other scheduling irregularities, *RFR* will maintain pre-recorded shows, substitute hosts and/or programming.

Along with weekly and monthly programs, daily scheduling will include station identification, musical interludes, regularly timed bulletins, notification if a call-in show was pre-recorded, and notifications of online updates to podcasts and other resources.
