
This letter is submitted pursuant to Section 73.1560(d) of the Commission's Rules. On behalf of our client, Taconite Broadcasting, Inc., the licensee of FM Broadcast Station WMQT-FM, Ishpeming, MI, this letter constitutes the necessary notification that WMQT-FM is now operating at reduced power at its licensed transmitter site pending repairs to the antenna and transmitter sustained in a recent winter storm. Specifically, for the past nine days, the station has been transmitting with an effective radiated power of only 750 watts on a backup transmitter due to damage to the antenna and/or feed line, and to the main transmitter sustained during a winter storm. Licensed ERP is 98 kW (H&V). The storm damage to the Station's antenna caused damage to the main transmitter. Repairs to both the transmitter and the antenna system have been delayed due to extreme cold and high winds. It is not anticipated that repairs can be effectuated this week because of the continued unusual cold and wind in Michigan.
