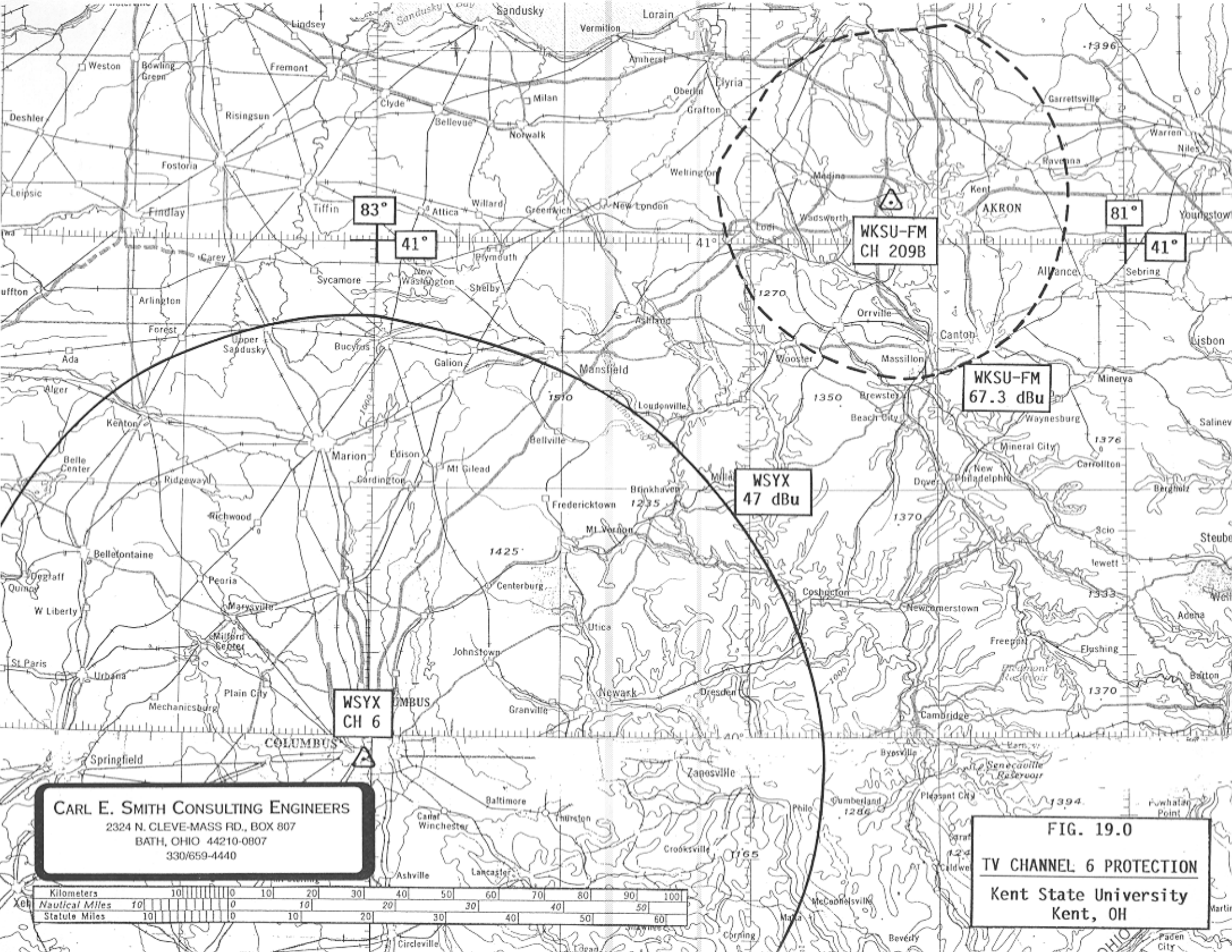

TV CHANNEL 6 PROTECTION

The protection standards with respect to TV stations operating on Channel 6 are outlined in Section 73.525 of the FCC Rules. This rule section states that stations operating on Channel 209 are required to give protection consideration to all Channel 6 TV stations located within 196 kilometers of their transmitter sites. In this case there is only one Channel 6 TV station located within this distance from the WKSU-FM site. This station is WSYX - Columbus, Ohio. Figure 2.1 is a map exhibit showing the 67.3 dBu, F(50,10) interfering contour for the proposed modified WKSU-FM facilities¹ in relation to the WSYX 47 dBu contour. As can be seen from an examination of this figure, there will be no overlap between these contours. Based upon this information, the proposed WKSU-FM facilities will provide the required protection to WSYX.

¹The value of the interfering contour for does not include the 6 dB adjustment for directional television receiving antennas permitted by Section 73.525(e)(1)(iii) of the FCC Rules.
