The proposed assignee, His Mercy Radio, Inc. (“HMR”) satisfies all of the criteria to serve as a licensee of low power FM radio station KJCR-LP. In particular:

1. Nonprofit Educational Organization and Educational Purpose

HMR is a nonprofit educational organization. As the attached Bylaws indicate, HMR was formed in 2018. As stated in those Bylaws, the purpose of HMR is to evangelize the culture through promoting the Catholic Faith and the teachings of the Magisterium of the Catholic Church through Catholic Radio and other media and activities. The means of dissemination include, yet are not limited to: books, audio CDs or files, pamphlets, seminars, lectures, exhibits, retreats, purchasing air time on radio or television, the internet or any other public media, as well as through ownership and operation of a Catholic Radio Station for broadcasting to the public.

Following Commission approval of this application and the consummation of the transaction proposed hereby, KJCR-LP will primarily broadcast the Eternal Word Television Network (“EWTN”) Catholic radio programming, with shows such as “Catholic Answers,” Daily Mass, “Called to Communion,” “EWTN Nightly News,” and the Holy Rosary. In addition, KJCR-LP may broadcast other Catholic programming, such as programs that may be made available from Relevant Radio, Mater Dei Radio, or others, in keeping with the goal of maintaining quality Catholic programming from reliable sources that are in alignment with the teachings of the Magisterium of the Catholic Church.

2. Certification re: Local Organization

By this application, the applicant and each member of HMR’s board of directors hereby certify that:

- (a) HMR is physically headquartered within 32.1 km (20 miles) of the KJCR-LP transmitter site. Grants Pass, Oregon is located outside of the top 50 urban markets; and
- (b) 100% of HMR’s board members reside within 32.1 km (20 miles) of the KJCR-LP transmitter site.

Based on the foregoing, HMR is qualified to serve as an LPFM licensee.
