

EXHIBIT 10

Bilingual Broadcasting Foundation, Inc. (“BBFI”), licensee of Noncommercial Educational Station KBBF(FM-NCE), Santa Rosa, CA, is a non-stock, non-profit organization. BBFI is filing this application to obtain Commission consent to new members of its Board of Directors. This application is intended to bring the station into compliance with the requirement to obtain FCC approval of the board after 50% of the members of the board of directors have changed.

The board changes occurred gradually over a two-year period. The board election held in 2007 was invalidated and the board members elected were not seated. Three new board members were appointed by the court this year. New elections will be held later this year.
