Dear Mr. Davis:

This is in reference to the request filed on April 11, 2016. CTL requests an extension of the STA granted on October 13, 2015, to operate during nighttime hours with an emergency ND antenna pursuant to Section 73.1680, due to failure of the control system.¹ In support of the request, CTL states that during the past six months the problems have been diagnosed and repair parts have been ordered.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.


Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and station

¹ WJDX(AM) is licensed for operation on 620 kHz with 5 kW day (ND) and 1 kW night (DA).

WJDX(AM) may continue to operate at night with an emergency ND antenna and a power of 0.25 kW, or with parameters at variance at night using reduced power if needed to maintain monitor points within licensed tolerances (after repairs have been completed). It will be necessary to further reduce or cease operation if complaints of interference are received. CTL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310. CTL must file an FCC Form 302 application to update the parameters shown on BZ-19871102AF before the expiration date shown below, or submit an e-mail /letter to certify night operations resumed with negligible changes.

This authority expires on **November 3, 2016**.
