**TECHNICAL STATEMENT**

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Magic Broadcasting Alabama Licensing, LLC ("Magic"), licensee of WJRL-FM, Channel 280C3, Ozark, Alabama. In MB Docket #04-146, WJRL-FM's community of license was changed from Ozark, Alabama to Fort Rucker, Alabama. This instant application seeks to implement the change in community of license. Magic proposes to implement this change at the existing WJRL-FM site. No actual technical changes are proposed herein.

Since Magic proposes for WJRL-FM to remain at its licensed site on the existing tower, the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") was not notified of this proposal. The tower has been registered with the FCC and assigned Antenna Structure Registration Number 1037907. At the existing site, Channel 280C3 does not meet the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements to one other station. As such, processing pursuant to §73.215 is requested (see Exhibit A).

The WJRL-FM antenna is located on a relatively short tower with another FM station. As such, the worksheets associated with Form 301 could not be used to demonstrate compliance

with the Commission's radio frequency exposure limits. Attached as Exhibit B is a radio frequency radiation study which shows WJRL-FM is in compliance with the Commission's RF rules.

All other necessary documentation used to certify the technical portion of FCC Form 301 has been forwarded to Magic and is available to the Commission upon request.<sup>1</sup>
