Hi Don, I'm sorry about the reception. The main issue is there is now a station from Walsenburg that went on the air near us on the "dial". That means our signal gets drowned out and we will have to move our frequency soon. We are currently searching for a stronger signal and we will let everyone know on the air and on our website when we are moving. We only have a translator in Pueblo so KOCK (that's what the call letters are) has the rights on that frequency. We promise to make it better as soon as we can. The consulting and the FCC approval takes about three months.
