DUO Ministries, Inc.

DUO Ministries, Inc. is a Nebraska non-profit corporation organized for educational and religious purposes. Its board members reside within 10 miles of the KJFT-LP transmitter and antenna site. Accordingly, DUO Ministries qualifies as an LPFM licensee pursuant to Section 73.853(b)(2) of the Commission's Rules.

Applicant's Educational Objective

DUO Ministries certifies that it will operate KJFT-LP in a manner consistent with Section 73.503 of the Commission's Rules. In *Columbia Bible College Broadcasting Co.*, 6 FCC Rcd 516 (1991), at paragraphs 9 and 10, the Commission stated that religiously-oriented applicants can meet the eligibility standards set forth in Section 73.503 of the Commission's Rules, where the applicant (1) proposes an overall educational program and (2) its proposed programming furthers its educational objectives. The proposed programming seeks to educate the public in Lincoln and Lancaster County about Christianity and living the Christian life. This is precisely the corporate purpose of DUO Ministries, Inc. Therefore, it is eligible pursuant to Section 73.503 to be licensee of the station covered by this application. Thus, like the applicant in *Columbia Bible*, *supra*, its application must be granted.

Use of Station for the Advancement of an Educational Program

DUO Ministries proposes to use KJFT-LP for the advancement of an educational program. In particular, KJFT-LP will broadcast programs to teach the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The applicant proposes to use KJFT-LP to present a comprehensive daily effort to educate the public, Christians and non-Christians, about the tenets of Christian life, including teachings of the Bible. Additional programming will consist of broadcasts of Christian music and talk. In sum, KJFT-LP will provide an important educational resource for the residents of Lincoln and Lancaster County, in the public interest, convenience and necessity.
