

Environmental Statement

The facility proposed in this application is to replace the existing KETS DTV channel 5 operation and will occupy the same location on the existing tower.

Calculations based upon information supplied by the antenna manufacturer, Jampro Antennas, Inc, indicate the field strengths in the area near the tower will be well below the non-ionizing radiation exposure limits.

The KETS-DT tower is located in a rural area consisting of pine forest owned by a large paper company, and as such is not in a historic district. The area is not located in any flood plains, restricted forest areas, protected wetlands, or wildlife refuges, etc.

The transmitter building, tower base, and guy wire anchor points are encircled with an eight-foot high chain link fence properly identified as a no trespassing, high RF radiation area.

It is the policy of KETS that all RF power to the antenna is removed whenever riggers are working on the tower.
