Dear Counsel:

This is in reference to the request filed January 31, 2012, on behalf of Sound of Life, Inc. ("SLI"). SLI requests further extension of the special temporary authority ("STA") granted on January 16, 2009, to operate Station WLJP with temporary facilities.<sup>1</sup> In support of the request, SLI states that it holds a construction permit to relocate the station. SLI states that construction of the new facilities is in progress but has been delayed by a problem with funding for the project. SLI states that it has identified new sources of funding and that it is waiting for approval.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Our review indicates that the licensee has made progress toward restoration of licensed operation, but additional time is required for completing the work. Thus, extension of STA is warranted.

<sup>1</sup> WLJP is licensed for operation on Channel 207A (89.3 MHz) with effective radiated power ("ERP") of 0.2 kilowatts (H&V) and antenna height above average terrain ("HAAT") of 317 meters. Construction Permit BMPED-200110509ACQ authorizes an upgrade to Class B1, relocation of the transmitter and operation with ERP of 1.58 kilowatts (Max-DA, H&V) and HAAT of 283 meters.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED. Station WLJP may continue to operate with the following facilities:

Channel	207 (89.3 MHz)
Effective radiated power:	0.18 kilowatt (H&V)
Antenna height:	
above ground:	51 meters
above mean sea level:	502 meters

SLI must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **October 30, 2012**.
