

**“Mattoon” Waiver Request  
W260CG – Facility ID 153753  
Requesting Relocation to Asheboro, NC**

In order to effectuate a move to Asheboro, NC by FM Translator W260CG, and to save the resources of the Commission, a “Mattoon” Waiver is being requested<sup>1</sup>. A grant of this waiver will allow W260CG to move to a location where it can be used with WZOO (AM) as the primary station. This move will be accomplished with only *one* Form 349 application. The important areas are:

No History of Translator Hops – W260CG is successfully licensed at Burlington, NC. In its short history, the currently licensed location is the only location from which W260CG has ever operated<sup>2</sup>.

Mutual Exclusivity - Following this Waiver Request is the exhibit “Demonstration of Mutual Exclusivity”. This exhibit illustrates the licensed 60 dBu protected and the proposed 40 dBu interfering contours of W260CG. These two contours produce an area that would be an interference area if both stations were allowed to operate simultaneously. Since both translators cannot operate simultaneously, they are mutually exclusive.


Fill In for AM – This W260CG proposal is to be a fill in translator for WZOO (AM), Asheboro, NC. Exhibit 10 of Section III-A demonstrates the translator 60 dBu is totally within the WZOO (AM) 2.0 mV/m contour. The total translator 60 dBu is also within 25 miles of the WZOO (AM) tower.

Concluding Request - It is respectfully requested that a “Mattoon” style waiver be allowed in order to provide fill-in FM translator service for WZOO (AM) in a timely, efficient manner.
