Notification of Suspension of Operation and Request for Special Temporary Authorization

Pursuant to Sections 73.561(d) and 73.1635 of the FCC's Rules, Mountain Lake Public Telecommunications Council ("MLPTC"), licensee of noncommercial educational Station WCFE-DT, DTV Channel 38, Plattsburgh, New York, hereby notifies the Commission of the Station's temporary suspension of operations and requests Special Temporary Authorization ("STA") to maintain the off-air status for more than thirty (30) days.

Station WCFE-TV was forced off the air on April 18, 2007 following severe damage to its transmitter tower. The approximately 400 foot tower collapsed completely and partially damaged the transmitter building at its base. MLPTC is assessing the extent of the damage, but currently believes that the structure may not be salvageable.

Accordingly, MLPTC is presently exploring options for repairing the station's transmission facilities and restoring its broadcast service. However, given the amount of time needed to rebuild the station's tower and obtain a replacement transmitter, MLPTC anticipates that WCFE-DT's broadcast facility will remain silent for more than thirty (30) days. Therefore, MLPTC also requests STA at this time for the continued silent status of the station. MLPTC respectfully submits that grant of an STA will serve the public interest by allowing it sufficient time to assess and respond to the circumstances beyond its control which have damaged the transmission facility and forced WCFE-DT off-air.

MLPTC is a noncommercial educational licensee and operates WCFE-DT on a noncommercial educational basis. This request is therefore exempt from FCC filing fee requirements, pursuant to Section 1.1114 of the Commission's Rules, and the facility is exempt from FCC regulatory fees, pursuant to Section 1.1162 of the Rules. This request is also exempt from the Anti-Drug Abuse Act certification requirements pursuant to Section 1.2002(c) of the Rules.
