With a radio station, AIAWJ can promote local talent, community organizations, and causes fostering positive images of low income and underserved populations, and increasing community awareness of existing available resources. A radio station can act as a catalyst for education, action and empowerment in our communities.

Radio Programming Guides

All my organizations: profiles about community organizations, their services, and the behind the scenes of their services

Coming soon to a venue near you: music show highlighting the music from bands and artists that will be performing in the valley

Community classroom: educational program on a wide range of subjects, such as English-language learning, sciences, maths, how to fix a car, how to fix electronics, practical application of academic subjects, etc.

Desert stories: storytelling and interviews from local Phoenixians

Exhibit This: art showings, galleries, museums, and other happenings in phoenix

Everything you never knew about _____: a radio segment going into depth about a shifting topic each week, focusing on the local. Things like architecture, businesses, local laws, history, people, etc.

From your barrio: neighborhood updates, block watch information, neighborhood services, neighborhood profiles, bilingual

Healthy Living: health and living information with highlights from local organizations

Here and there: discussion on national and international news and the impacts in the phoenix-metro area

In your own voice: radio segment for non-english programming (most likely non-spanish as well, serves the large refugee community in phoenix-metro area)

Less often heard: music show with off-brand indie music

Local talk: local talk show on a variety of subjects with local professionals and experts

Music from the valley of the sun: local music hour playing music from local bands and artists

Musica desde la phoeniquera: local music hour, playing music from local bands and artists. Spanish/latino focus

News hour/hora de noticias: local news, traffic, etc. in Spanish and English

Of AZ past: segments on interesting Arizona history

Open mic: open mic performances from local artists such as slam poetry, storytelling, singing, theater, etc.

Poetry hour: local poetry reading

Publicly produced content and community call ins: an opportunity for the Phoenix Community Radio program to teach the community about radio reporting and put their voices on the air. Help interested community members come up with their own radio programs to air. Accept call ins and suggestions and answer them

Radio Theater phoenix: radio theater performances, storytelling, monologues, etc.

Vamos a Comer/Let's Eat: restaurant profiles in the valley

What's cookin'/que cocinamos: local cooking shows, recipes, etc.

Youthspeak: youth radio hour, offering opportunity to youth media and radio programs, high school journalism students, and other interested youth to produce their own radio segment
