The construction permit as issued by the Commission contained three special conditions or restrictions. This exhibit demonstrates that the applicant is in compliance with these three conditions.

The first restriction requires the permittee to coordinate with other users of the site to reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site from exposure to radiofrequency radiation in excess of the applicable safety standards. The permittee certifies that during the construction period, necessary measures were taken to prevent harmful exposure to workers at the site. In addition, the permittee certifies that when future work is required at the site, that the facility will reduce power or cease operation as necessary to prevent workers from being exposed to harmful levels of radiation in excess of the applicable safety standards.

Restriction 2 indicates that the permittee specified use of a Shively 6602-4SS type antenna to demonstrate compliance with the RF safety standards. The condition also states that the provisions of automatic program test authority do not apply if another type of antenna is utilized. As the form pages indicate, the permittee has installed the antenna type proposed.

The third condition indicates that the allotment, to which this application pertains, was automatically modified to channel 272A from channel 272C as of the date of the grant of the pertinent authorization. This condition/restriction does not require any additional action to be taken by the permittee.
