

Request for Extension of Special Temporary Authority

WLII/WSUR License Partnership, G.P., licensee of WUKQ-FM1, Facility ID 127832, Ponce, Puerto Rico, (the “Station”) respectfully requests a six-month extension of its current Special Temporary Authority (“STA”) to operate at reduced power while the Station pursues a permanent resolution to previously raised complaints of interference from AT&T related to the Station’s broadcast booster facility. The original STA, granted on February 21, 2020, authorizes the Station to operate at reduced power in order to allow it to work with the transmitter manufacturer to identify the source of any complained-of interference. Since grant of its last extension request, the Station has installed a 98.7 MHz Band Pass Filter that appears to have alleviated the interference with AT&T operations. However, in order to ensure against future complaints, the Station is contemplating additional technical changes. Unfortunately, because of the continued effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, the contemplated transmitter parts remain unavailable. Accordingly, the Station seeks an additional six month extension of the current STA.

Grant of this STA extension is in the public interest as it will result in a mutually satisfactory resolution between the Station and AT&T. Once the transmitter parts become available from the manufacturer, the Station will notify the Staff when the remaining technical issues are more permanently resolved.
