Explanation of Circumstances Warranting Grant of STA

Pappas Telecasting of the Treasure Coast, LLC (“Pappas Telecasting”) holds a license from the Commission that authorizes Pappas Telecasting to operate low-power television station WMMF-LP in Vero Beach, FL (the “Station”) on NTSC Channel 57. Station WMMF-LP bears the Commission’s Facility Identification Number 36239.

As we notified the Commission in our letter to the Commission’s Secretary that was dated and filed with the Commission on behalf of Pappas Telecasting on November 1, 2007, the Station temporarily suspended broadcast operations on October 22, 2007, due to financial constraints. Pappas Telecasting is actively working to develop a strategic plan for the optimal use of the Station’s resources in order to resolve this situation, and so that the Station may resume its broadcast service at the earliest practicable date.

Accordingly, as required by Section 74.763(b) of the Commission’s Rules and Regulations, WMMF-LP respectfully requests a special temporary authorization (“STA”) from the Commission to permit Station WMMF-LP to remain “dark” for more than 30 consecutive days. It is hoped and believed that an STA of six (6) months duration will prove sufficient to resolve the Station’s current operational/financial challenges. The public interest will be served by a grant of the STA, because this STA will allow Station WMMF-LP to continue serving its viewers, once its challenging financial situation is resolved.
