EXHIBIT "A"

To lease radio broadcasting time or to establish, maintain, own and operate a radio station broadcasting exclusively programming which promotes a better understanding of the doctrines and liturgy of the Roman Catholic Church and to enrich the lives of those within their listening area. Also, to campaign for and receive, hold and apply funds, gifts and bequests for the maintenance and operation of such a radio station.

This organization is organized exclusively for religious and educational purposes.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be attributable to its Directors officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth above. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law).

The religious and educational purposes of the Corporation shall include the following:

- a) to receive and administer funds for the benefit of the Corporation, or its successor and to that end to take and hold, by bequest, devise, gift, purchase or lease, either absolutely or in trust, any property, real, personal or mixed, without limitation as to amount or value, except such limitations, if any, as may be imposed by law;
- b) to borrow money and issue evidence of indebtedness in furtherance of the religious and educational purposes of this Corporation and to secure same by mortgages, pledge, or other lien on property;
- c) to sell, lease, borrow, encumber, exchange, subdivide, convey and dispose of such property (as mentioned in a) above) and to invest and reinvest principal and income thereof and to deal with and expend principal and income therefrom for the purpose set forth in these Articles without limitation, except such limitations, if any, as may be contained in the instrument under which such property is received or such limitations, if any, as may be imposed by law;
- d) to own, use, buy, sell, mortgage or encumber real and personal property as will tend to promote the objects of this Corporation and the doing of all things necessary or incident to the purposes of this Corporation; and to do such other lawful acts or activities to accomplish its religious and

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educational purposes as contemplated by Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) and the nonprofit corporation laws of the State of Ohio.

SIXTH

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, religious or educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization(s) under Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization(s) as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for said purposes.
