Request for Tolling

Dear Mr. Peltzman:

On June 19, 2019, we received the request for tolling of the construction deadline for a construction permit (File No. BNPL-20131114BHE, modified by BMPL-20190513ABJ) for LPFM Station KSXS-LP, Los Angeles, California, that you filed on behalf of the Los Angeles Social Justice Radio Project (LASJRP). That permit was granted on June 23, 2016 for a three-year term ending on June 23, 2019. LASJRP's tolling request is based on the lawsuit filed in the Superior Court of the State of California for the County of Los Angeles, Case No. 19CHCV00246 dated June 3, 2019, in which a dispute over ownership and right of way to the transmitter site property was challenged. This court matter was preceded by other legal disputes over the right to access the transmitter site property. This request falls within one of the criteria for tolling in 47 C.F.R. §73.3598(b) and is granted. Pursuant to §73.3598(c) of the rules, because the request was filed more than 30 days from the date that the tolling event occurred (court order), we look back 30 days from the date of filing to determine the effective date of tolling. I have placed a note in the station's record in our public database indicating that the request was granted on June 20, 2019, effective May 19, 2019.

Grant of the request is subject to the following conditions:

Tolling is effective as of May 19, 2019. Once tolling ends, 34 days will remain on the permit.

Tolling will remain in effect until January 20, 2020, absent earlier resolution of the court matter. If the matter is not resolved within six months, LASJRP would need to file a status report by January 20, 2020, and at six-month intervals thereafter, requesting continued tolling treatment.

LASJRP also must notify us within 30 days of the lawsuit being resolved.

When tolling ends (either because LASJRP has not filed a request for continued tolling or because the matter has been resolved) we will calculate a new permit expiration date by adding the remaining 34 days.
