Dear Mr. McGlynn:

This is in reference to the request filed on May 31, 2022. GMC requests a further extension of the STA granted on May 12, 2017, to continue operating with parameters at variance and reduced power to allow time to file the required FCC Form 302 application.¹ In support of the request, GMC stated that additional time will be needed to complete all remaining work and file the application to cover the construction permit BP-20191028AAL.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

We note that the previous STA expired on April 20, 2022, therefore the authority granted will not cover the period between the expiration of the prior STA and the filing date of the this new request, and is without prejudice as to whatever action the Commission may take with respect to operation during the foregoing period.

¹ WRSB(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1590 kHz with 1 kW day and night, using different patterns, and BP-20191028AAL authorizes ND operation on 1600 kHz, using reduced power and one of the existing towers.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and GMC may continue to operate on 1590 kHz with DA parameters at variance from licensed values and reduced power in order to maintain all monitor points within licensed limits. GMC must reduce power or cease operation if complaints of interference are received, and use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commissions exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR §1.1310. GMC must submit an e-mail to my attention to note the date the application was filed with the audiofilings team.

This authority expires on **December 2, 2022**.
