Dear Mr. Nelson:

This is in reference to the request filed on June 1, 2018. NMI requests a further extension of the STA granted on March 4, 2002, to continue operating using a long wire antenna pending the filing of the required FCC Form 301 application due to loss of the licensed site.¹ In support of the request, NMI states that it plans to file the application to propose a new permanent facility based upon the proposed AM revitalization rules.²

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

Accordingly, the request for extension of the STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and NMI

may continue to operate using the following facilities:

Geographic Coordinates:	41° 51' 11" NL, 88° 19' 38" WL (NAD 1927)
Frequency:	1480 kHz
Operating hours:	Unlimited
Operating power:	0.125 kW
Antenna:	Long wire

NMI must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310. NMI must file the 301 application before (or immediately after) the proposed AM rules have been adopted.

This authority expires on **December 19, 2018**.
