Dear Applicants:

This is with respect to the above-referenced application filed by International Communications Network, Inc. ("ICN") for displacement relief on channel 25 for unbuilt digital station K09YL-D at National City, California. Entravision Holdings, LLC ("Entravision"), the licensee of station KDTF-CA, San Diego, California, filed a motion to dismiss.

ICN, the licensee of out-of-core analog station K61GH at National City, filed a digital displacement application for channel 50. That application was granted and ICN filed a license to cover construction of that facility.<sup>1</sup> Entravision is correct that the licensee of an analog station may convert to digital operations on only one channel. Because ICN has licensed its channel 50 digital facility, the construction permit for K09YL-D IS CANCELLED and the above-referenced displacement application IS DISMISSED.
