**Memorandum of Agreement**



M. Kent Frandsen ("Frandsen") licensee of Station KZHK(FM), Channel 240C, St. George, UT, FCC Facility ID No. 40519, and College Creek Media, LLC ("College Creek") licensee of Station KHIJ(FM), Channel 242C, Mesquite, NV, FCC Facility ID No. 164142 (collectively, the "Parties"), hereby evince their agreement to each file simultaneously with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"), pursuant to the Report and Order in MB Docket 05-210, 71 Fed. Reg. 76208 (December 20, 2006), an FCC Form 301 Application for KZHK(FM) and KHIJ(FM) for Minor-Change Construction Permits.

In MB Docket 01-135, channel 240C was deleted at St. George, UT, and mutually exclusive channel 240C was added at Bunkerville, NV, as that community's first local transmission service for KZHK(FM)'s use. Pursuant to the Report and Order to that Docket, KZHK(FM) was granted construction permit BPH-20050404AED to implement the community change. KZHK(FM) has not initiated service to Bunkerville since it has not implemented this construction permit and, instead, desires to remain in St. George, UT, at its presently licensed site. As such, KZHK(FM) is instantly proposing to, in effect, "return" to St. George at its currently licensed facilities. However, so as to not deprive Bunkerville, NV, of its sole "potential" local transmission service and secure the first local transmission service benefits provided in MB Docket 01-135, College Creek, by this contingent set of applications, will specify replacing Bunkerville, Utah's, sole local transmission service (KZHK) with KHIJ(FM)'s facilities operating on Channel 244C at its currently licensed site. As is shown in the instant application, since several stations currently serve KHIJ(FM)'s current community of Mesquite, NV, the removal of KHIJ(FM) from Mesquite as a result of the contingent applications does not negatively impact the public interest.

The Parties request that the FCC staff simultaneously process and grant their Applications for Minor-Change Construction Permits.
