

Other Broadcast Interests

This application is one of seven simultaneously filed FCC Form 316 applications seeking Commission consent to the *pro forma* involuntary transfer of control of seven commonly owned television station licenses following the death of the principal shareholder. Specifically, these applications seek consent to the involuntary transfer of control from Milton R. Grant (deceased) to his Estate, which occurred automatically upon Mr. Grant's death on April 28, 2007.

The decedent, Milton R. Grant held 100% of the stock of Grant Company, Inc., which, through various subsidiaries, owned and controlled seven television broadcast stations (detailed below). Upon his death, Mr. Grant's assets, including the stock, became assets of the Estate of Milton R. Grant by operation of Florida law.
