Dear Mr. Benedict:

This letter is in reference to the above-captioned minor change application filed by CBS Radio, Inc. (CBS) to change site and antenna system, and the September 24, 2008, amendment. We noted that a request for waiver of Sect 73.182 with respect to KLAA(AM) and KMPH(AM) is included in the application. We will hold the application for Mexican approval and not address waiver at this point due to reasons shown below.

A preliminary review of the amended application reveals that the FCC's International Bureau (IB) staff has received a Mexican objection to the currently licensed daytime KXNT(AM) facilities due to alleged groundwave interference to co-channel Mexican station XE, Rosario de Arriba, Baja California. Consequently, the daytime proposal must be notified to Mexico for approval. In addition, the nighttime parameters must be notified to Mexico because the nighttime proposal enters the 50% RSS of "objected" Mexican stations XENVA2, Nogales, Sonora and XENVA2, JANOS, Chihuahua, Mexico. Accordingly, we recommend that CBS amend the application with exhibits clearly indicating adequate protection has been provided to all Mexican stations. All questions concerning foreign records should be directed to George Felhner of IB at (202) 418-2197.

Further action on the subject application will be withheld for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to provide an opportunity to file a curative electronic amendment. Failure to amend or respond within this time period will result in the dismissal of the application pursuant to Section 73.3568 of the Commission's rules.
