Request for Extension of Special Temporary
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Ms. O'Connor:

This letter concerns the request you filed on February 26, 2016, on behalf of Educational Media Foundation ("EMF"), for extension of Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to permit FM Translator Station K232CU to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that EMF stated that Station K232CU went silent on August 4, 2015, because it lost its programming source. The previous STA was granted on September 1, 2015, and expired on February 28, 2016. EMF requests extension of its STA for continuing programming issues. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

EMF's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station K232CU to remain silent until August 4, 2016. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station K232CU will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., August 5, 2016.¹**

EMF is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If EMF does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
