Application 1 – BPED-20171005AAL – Ch 207C2; location: 34-33-5 NL, 114-11-36 WL; ERP – 0.415 kw; HAAT – 839 m; RCAMSL – 1467 m; RCAGL – 40 m  
Application 2 – BPED-20180209ACB – Ch 207A; location: 34-29-10 NL, 114-13-8 WL; ERP – 1.5 kw; HAAT – 119 m; RCAMSL – 637 m; RCAGL – 34 m

We are awaiting Mexican concurrence for Application 1, and Application 2 is grantable.

Please let me know what the plan is for KAIH (I note that an STA was granted today, so apparently its silent status is not an issue).
