

Pappas Telecasting of the Midlands, a California Limited Partnership (“PT/Midlands”), holds the Commission licenses for UHF analog commercial low-power television broadcasting stations KAZO-LP, Omaha, Nebraska (Facility I.D. No. 51498), and K57HV, Columbus, Nebraska (Facility I.D. No. 21157). The equity in PT/Midlands is currently held by Harry J. Pappas, as a 55% general partner and as a 39% limited partner; Pappas Telecasting of Nebraska, Inc., as a 2% general partner; and LeBon G. Abercrombie and Dennis J. Davis, each as 2% limited partners. Harry J. Pappas holds 100% of the stock of Pappas Telecasting of Nebraska, Inc.

The instant application requests the Commission’s consent to a transaction whereby the licenses for Stations KAZO-LP and K57HV will be assigned by PT/Midlands to TV Américas de Omaha, LLC (“TV Américas”), a Delaware limited liability company. The equity in TV Américas is currently held by Harry J. Pappas, as a 94% member; Pappas Telecasting of Nebraska, Inc., as a 2% managing member; and LeBon G. Abercrombie and Dennis J. Davis, both as 2% members. Harry J. Pappas will continue to hold 100% of the stock of Pappas Telecasting of Nebraska, Inc.

Harry J. Pappas, LeBon G. Abercrombie, and Dennis J. Davis are all United States citizens. Mr. Pappas’ address is 245 Ranch Road, Visalia, California 93291.
