**Re: Waiver of Construction Deadline for Construction Permit
 BMPFT-20160729AOL**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

E-String Wireless, Ltd. ("E-String") and NRG License Sub, LLC ("NRG") filed an assignment application with the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC") on July 29, 2016, seeking to assign the construction permit for unbuilt FM Translator Station K247CA (now K258DC), Iowa City, Iowa (Facility ID No. 156462) from E-String to NRG (File No. BAPFT-20160729AOI), which was granted on October 4, 2016.

E-String filed a "250 Mile Modification" application for K247CA, which was granted on August 24, 2016 (BMPFT-20160729AOL). The purpose of the modification is to allow NRG to rebroadcast KMMQ (AM), Plattsmouth, NE, on the translator. After consummation, NRG will build the modified translator promptly.

The K247CA/K258DC Construction Permit is currently scheduled to expire on January 22, 2017. E-String accordingly requests a waiver of the construction deadline for the Construction Permit pursuant to Footnote 36 of the FCC's October 23, 2015 "AM Revitalization" Order, FCC 15-142, for six months from the consummation of the assignment.


