

The following operating conditions and restrictions were specified on the construction permit for K281AX. A response for each is noted.

1. Prior to commencing program test operations, FM Translator or FM Booster permittee must have on file at the Commission, FCC Form 350, Application for an FM Translator or FM Booster Station License, pursuant to 47 C.F.R. Section 74.14.

Response: Application has been filed

2. The permittee/licensee must reduce power or cease operation as necessary to protect persons having access to the site, tower or antenna from radiofrequency electromagnetic fields in excess of FCC guidelines.

Response: The permittee/licensee has a written policy posted at the site with instructions on how to terminate transmission if persons must work in the immediate vicinity of the antenna.


3. Warning signs which describe the radiofrequency electromagnetic field must be posted at appropriate intervals. Access must be restricted to prevent the exposure of humans to RF emissions in excess of the FCC guidelines (OET Bulletin No. 65, Edition 97-01, released August 1997). Permittee shall submit documentation of compliance with this special operating condition when filing FCC Form 350, application for license.

Response: The antenna is pole mounted on the side of a building at the height indicated on the construction permit. The antenna used is the same as specified in the application for construction permit. As specified in the construction permit application the antenna radiation pattern does not put persons at ground level in danger of exposure exceeding FCC guidelines.

4. Permittee has specified use of the antenna listed below to demonstrate compliance with the FCC radiofrequency electromagnetic field exposure guidelines. If any other type or size of antenna is to be used with the facilities authorized herein, THE AUTOMATIC PROGRAM TEST PROVISIONS OF 47 C.F.R. SECTION 73.1620 WILL NOT APPLY. In this case a FORMAL REQUEST FOR PROGRAM TEST AUTHORITY must be filed in conjunction with FCC Form 350, application for license, BEFORE program tests will be authorized. This request should be made at least 10 days prior to the date on which program tests are desired to commence. The request must include a revised RF field showing to demonstrate continued compliance with the FCC guidelines.

Documentation demonstrating compliance with the FCC radiofrequency field exposure guidelines may be submitted in advance of the filing of FCC Form 350. The Commission's staff will review it for compliance and respond by letter stating whether automatic PTA has been reinstated.

Response: The antenna used is the same as specified in the application for construction permit.
